### Article of Faith I

The witness of Scripture is that the Holy Bible, consisting of the sixty-six books of the Old and New Testaments, is a divine revelation, the original autographs of which were verbally inspired by the Holy Spirit. Scripture is absolute in authority, complete in revelation, final in content, and infallible in its statements (Luke 1:1-4; 24:27, 44-46, 48; John 5:39; Acts 1:16; 17:11; 26:6-7, 26; Rom 15:4; 1 Cor 2:13; 2 Tim 3:16; 2 Pet 1:21).

### Article of Faith II

There are three distinct personalities in the Godhead: the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit; and these three Persons are one God, the same in substance, eternally equal in power and glory (Deut 6:4; Isa 6:8; Matt 28:19; 1 Cor 8:6; 2 Cor 13:14; 1 John 5:7).

### Article of Faith III

Jesus Christ is the image of the invisible God, that is, He is Himself very God; He took upon Himself human nature, being conceived of the Holy Spirit, born of the virgin Mary, lived a sinless life; He died upon the cross as a substitutionary sacrifice for sin; He died and arose bodily the third day in the body in which He was crucified; He ascended into heaven in that body glorified, where He is now, as interceding High Priest of all who believe in Him; He will come again personally, bodily, and visibly to establish His kingdom and to judge the quick and the dead (Matt 1:18-25; 25:31-46; Luke 24; Acts 1:9-11; 2:31-36; Phil 2:5-8; Col 1:15; 1 Thess 4:16-18; Heb 4:14-16; 1 Pet 2:24, 25; Rev 11:15-17; 20:4-6, 11-15).

### Article of Faith IV

Adam was created in the image of God, but fell into sin, which resulted in being separated from God, and in that sense, is lost; this is true of all men, since Adam was the federal head of all mankind thus by one man sin entered the world, resulting in death entering the world, and so death was passed upon all man, so that all have sinned. Except a man be born again by the free and sovereign work of the Holy Spirit, he cannot enter the kingdom of God; man can in no way atone for his own sin; the retribution of the wicked and unbelieving and the reward of the righteous are everlasting, and as the reward is conscious, so is the retribution (Gen 1:26-27; 3:1-13; Matt 25:46; John 3:16; Acts 13:38-39; 4:12; Rom 3:10, 23; 5:12; 7:18; 2 Cor 5:1; 11:3; Eph 2:8-9; 2 Thess 1:7-10).

### Article of Faith V

Salvation is a gift of God, by grace through faith in the Lord Jesus Christ alone, who died a voluntary and substitutionary death upon the cross at Calvary as the once-for-all sacrifice for sin. Those who trust in Jesus Christ by faith alone have their sins forgiven; are born into the family of God by the baptism of the Holy Spirit, thus becoming children of God; and are made new creatures in Christ Jesus. Faith and repentance are inseparable graces produced by the regenerating work of the Holy Spirit (John 1:12-13; 3:1-21; Rom 6:23; 1 Cor 15:3; 2 Cor 5:17; Eph 1:7; 2:8, 9; Heb 10:10-12; 1 Pet 2:23-24).

*For momentary, light affliction is producing for us an eternal weight of glory far beyond all comparison, while we look not at the things which are seen, but at the things which are not seen; for the things which are seen are temporal, but the things which are not seen are eternal.*



## Our Purpose

Ron J. Bigalke Jr. (BS; MAbol; MTS; MDiv; PhD) established Eternal Ministries in 1999 as a missionary organization that is dedicated to proclaiming the Gospel of grace and systematically teaching the Word of God. The ministry functions primarily as the discipleship and evangelistic outreach of Ron Bigalke, and works through the advisory of Biblical Ministries Worldwide. Eternal Ministries is a biblical resource for literature, teaching, training, Bible seminars, and conferences.

## Background

Prior to becoming a Christian, Dr. Ron J. Bigalke Jr. began studying Western philosophy that led to an absorption in many aspects of New Age/occult/Eastern thinking and practices. These beliefs and practices resulted in vain imaginations and a darkened heart (cf. Rom 1). It was from a life of paganism in which God called Ron to salvation by grace through faith in Jesus Christ alone.

Dr. Bigalke has more than ten years of experience in numerous discipleship and evangelistic ministries. He has instructed Bible institute / college & seminary courses, and continues to lecture. His church and leadership experience includes conference speaking, pastoral ministry, pulpit ministry, and youth ministry. Dr. Bigalke is an ordained minister, and partner of apologetics evangelism (SBC). He is a missionary of Biblical Ministries Worldwide, and a member of several Christian professional societies. His teaching experience also includes service as secondary teacher and administrator, in addition to service on several school boards. Dr. Bigalke is a frequent contributor to various publications, such as journals, newsletters, reference works (encyclopedia, handbook), and web articles, in addition to being the general editor of four books. His current literature ministry encompasses apologetics, biblical studies, church thought, historiography, and political theory / theology. *His undying commitment is to the preservation and promotion of biblical, conservative, evangelical theology in the life of the church.*

## Our Program

**Training centers** are used for the purpose of recruiting and training of God-called missionaries.

**Conferences and seminars** communicating apologetics, biblical studies, Christian worldview, discipleship, personal evangelism, and pulpit exegesis are hosted by churches and schools throughout the nation.

**Weekly Bible studies** modeling pulpit exegesis (verse-by-verse systematic Bible teaching).

The **literature ministry** includes book publications, and ongoing contributions to various other publications, such as journal, magazine, newsletter, reference work (encyclopedia, handbook), and web articles. This ministry extends to audio/MP3 studies.

**Correspondence, online, and traditional courses** (with mentoring opportunities) are available for either certification or college / seminary credit. (Dr. Bigalke serves as professor of Bible and theology for Tyndale Theological Seminary, in addition to mentor for Columbia Evangelical Seminary.)

**Discipleship retreats** are held with the primary purpose for leadership development and the training of men (and teams) for planting churches.

The **educational ministry** provides resources for Christian classical homeschooling.

## Future Programs

- (1) making disciples of Jesus Christ in the Georgia political arena
- (2) church planting and healthy local church reproduction in metro Atlanta, and extending throughout the southeast (especially coastal Georgia, and extending to Hardeeville and Hilton Head, South Carolina).
